

ABOUT CASA OF JOHNSON & WYANDOTTE COUNTIES

Our mission is to provide a meaningful voice and connection that instills hope and builds resilience for children who have experienced abuse and neglect, and our vision is to create a community where every child who has experienced abuse and neglect is given the opportunity to thrive.

SPONSORSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

Diamond Sponsor – \$10,000

Supports staff positions and expands the number of advocates CASA can recruit, train, and assign to children in foster care. Includes premium recognition and 2 reserved tables (20 guests).

Platinum Sponsor – \$5,000

Supports child-focused programs and events such as CASA's Holiday Drive, Hygiene Drive, and Fostering Futures, helping ensure children in foster care have the essentials, opportunities, and support they need to thrive. Includes 1 reserved table (10 guests).

Gold Sponsor – \$2,500

It all started when a couple of SOC founding members were craving boiled crawfish back in 2001. These two crawfish enthusiasts held their first annual boil inviting 30 people to share a hundred pounds of live crawfish flown from New Orleans to Kansas City for the party. The challenge was their friends didn't know how to peel the little crustaceans, so a lot of time was spent giving peeling lessons. Those same friends are now skilled peelers and connoisseurs.

The Overland Park Rotary Club has a rich history of raising funds to support children's charities in greater Kansas City. From 1989 to 2017, the Club produced Jazz in the Woods, which since the event's inception, allowed the Club to donate more than \$1,500,000 to local children's charities.
